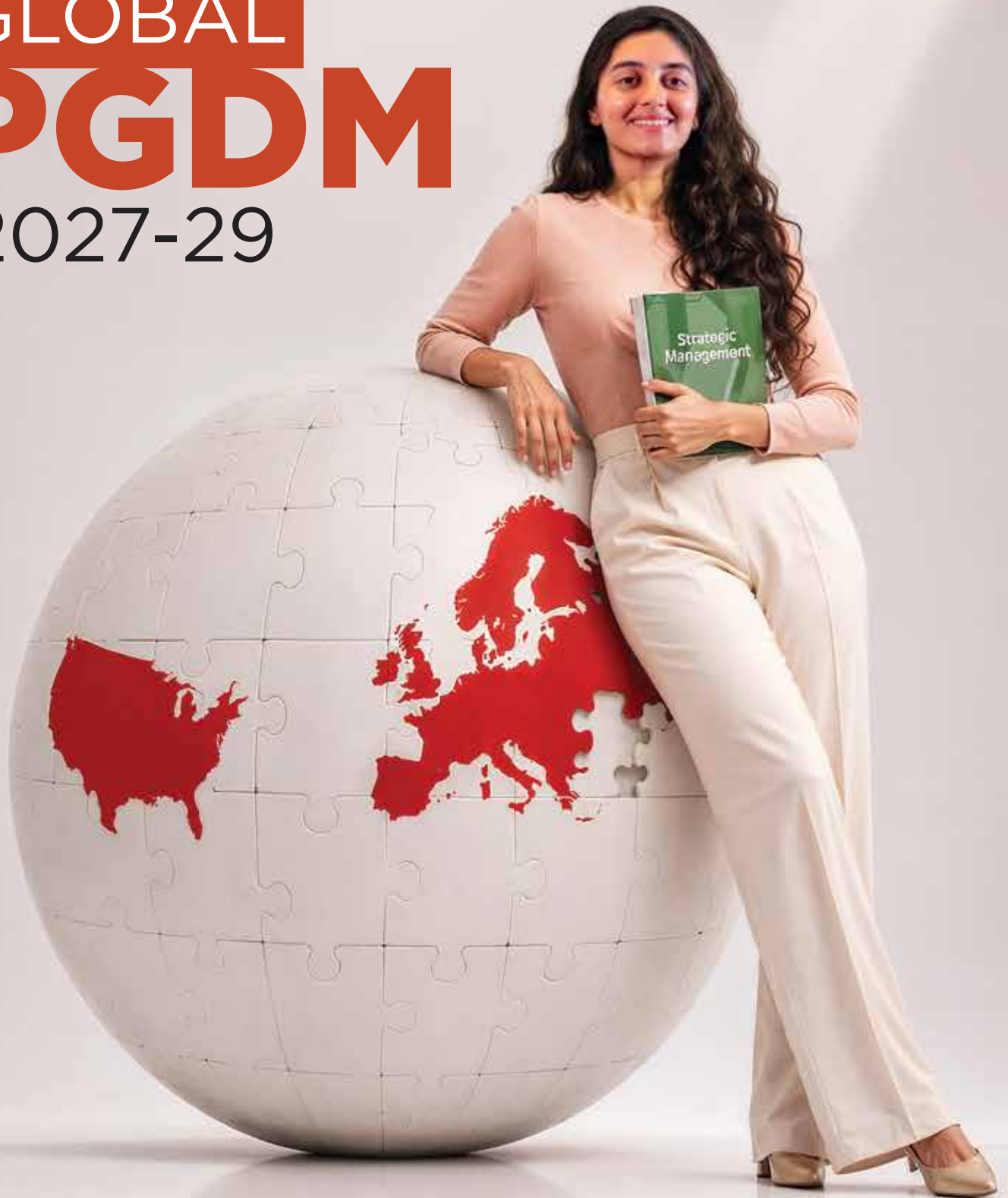

This program is designed to give students genuine cross-cultural exposure and a global perspective.

Under this program, students have the option of spending one semester or two semesters at a partner university abroad through ISBR's exchange arrangement. Beyond building a strong international network, students learn directly from faculty at these partner institutions-drawn from across America, Europe, and Asia - gaining the best of both Indian and global education.

Students are immersed in a truly multi-national peer group and take part in corporate and academic tours throughout the program, offering invaluable insight into how global business really works.

The program combines academic exchange with corporate immersion tours, helping students build a global professional network and develop the cross-cultural fluency today's business expect from future leaders

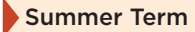
PGDM with Two Semesters Abroad

For students seeking deeper immersions, ISBR's Global PGDM with Two Semesters Abroad offers an extended two-semester track abroad - typically split across two partner universities in two different countries, spanning regions like the US, Europe, and Asia. Graduate with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks or equivalent from a recognized university

Entrance Test Accepted

CAT/ XAT/ MAT /CMAT /NMAT /ISBR Aptitude Test

Selection Process

Shortlisted applicants will be required to appear for

- Micropresentation
- Personal Interview

Frequently Asked Questions

Where will I go for my Semester Abroad or Global PGDM?

You will study at one of ISBR's partner universities, depending on your eligibility, preferences, and seat availability.

How long is the study abroad program?

One Semester Abroad: Approximately 3-4 months | Two Semesters Abroad: Approximately 6-8 months

When will the exchange take place?

Exchange semesters usually begin in January or late August, depending on the academic calendar of the partner university.

What are the estimated living expenses?

You should budget approximately ₹3-5 lakhs per semester, including airfare, visa, insurance, accommodation, meals, and local travel. Actual costs may vary by destination.

Can I work while studying abroad?

In most cases, no. Student exchange visas generally do not permit part-time employment.

Can I do an internship during the exchange?

The exchange focuses on academics. Since the semester is short and academically intensive, internships are generally not included.

Can I volunteer?

Absolutely! Many partner universities offer volunteering opportunities, especially in research projects, student organizations, or community activities.

How will studying abroad benefit me?

You'll gain international exposure, develop a global mindset, build cross-cultural skills, and strengthen your profile for higher studies and future careers.

How do I apply?

The ISBR International Office will nominate eligible students. After nomination, the partner university will guide you through the application process. Once you're accepted, ISBR will support you with documentation and visa guidance.

How are accommodation arrangements made?

The partner university will help connect you with approved accommodation providers or university housing before your arrival.

What type of accommodation can I expect?

Most students stay in shared student hostels or shared apartments, depending on the destination.

How much does accommodation cost?

The type of accommodation you choose will decide the costing. Typically students end up sharing apartments or university dorms based on the availability.

How many courses will I study?

You'll take a course load equivalent to what you would normally study at ISBR.

Are the credits transferable?

Yes. Credits earned at the partner university will be transferred to ISBR as per the approved credit transfer policy.

Will I have to take additional exams at ISBR?

No. If you successfully complete and pass your approved courses abroad, those credits and grades will be transferred to ISBR.

Do recruiters in India value international exchange experience?

Yes. Employers appreciate global exposure, international learning, and cross-cultural skills. Be sure to highlight these experiences on your resume.

Can I get a job abroad after graduation?

Some partner universities offer pathways to further study or career opportunities. You can explore these options based on the country's visa regulations and your career goals.

What should I do before I travel?

Carry all your important documents, arrange a local SIM card after arrival, and open a local bank account as soon as you settle in. ISBR will guide you through the pre-departure process.
